Pinellas Safe Harbor is a new homeless shelter in Clearwater. This facility is intended to be used as a portal of reentry for inmates reentering the community from Florida Department of Corrections and the Pinellas County Jail, as well as homeless people off the streets. The facility is for men and women. The District 1 Corrections Committee is responsible for carrying the message of Alcoholics Anonymous to this facility 3 nights a week: Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 7:00pm to 8:00pm.

The committee is looking for home groups to bring AA meetings into this facility for monthly commitments of one night a week.

The group representative would be responsible for making sure that members of that group would show up on their committed night for the entire month. Pinellas Safe Harbor requires no background checks. The Corrections Committee asks that AA members leading these meetings have at least one year of sobriety.

The Corrections Committee is also looking for individuals with over a year of sobriety willing to obtain a background check to help carry the message of Alcoholics Anonymous into jails.
