To redefine Prudent Reserve as an amount equal to the average monthly operating expense for past 12 months, times three. The checkbook balance at the 1st of the month is maintained at one month's operating expenses separate from the prudent reserve. Any excess funds from the checking account will be distributed quarterly with 20% to General Service Office in New York, 40% of Area 15 South Florida, and 40% to District 1 within Area 15.

October 2006 Helpline Report

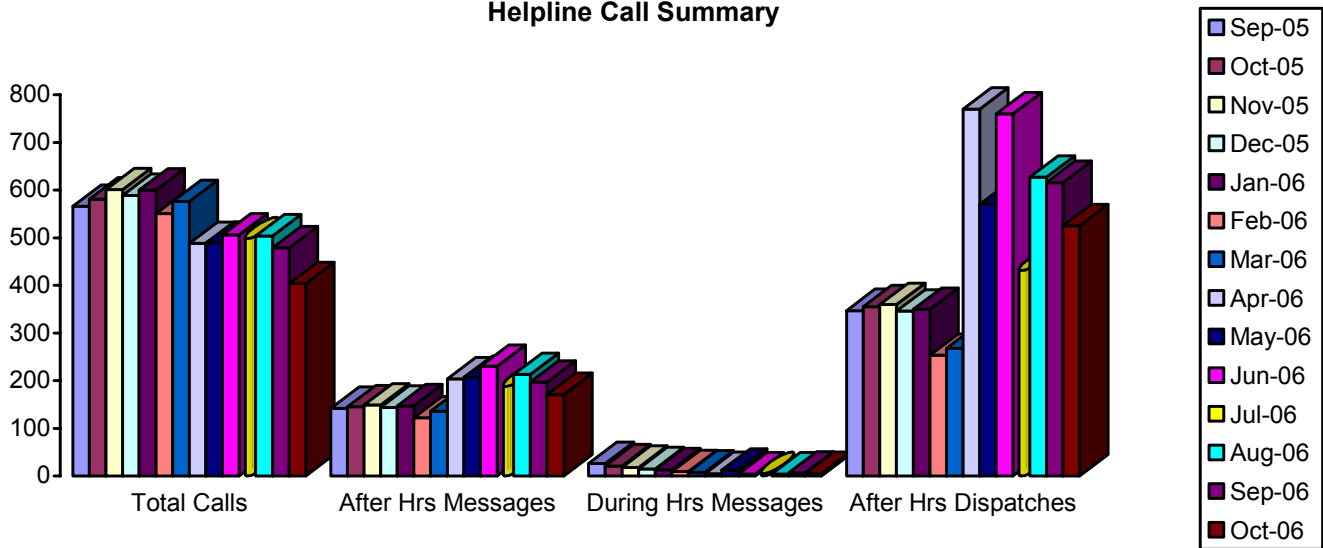
Pinellas County AA Helpline was staffed during the month of October by:

4. She noticed a lot of carpet stains. She admitted there had been several community events at the facility throughout the previous week and in actuality the stains were probably nothing more than a cumulative total from all of the traffic combined.

In conclusion, she indicated that she would improve communications with all future community groups to include definitive instructions as to what will be expected of them once their function is complete. She further indicated that there was nothing she expected us to do to rectify the situation. Her purpose in the phone call was to advise us for future reference.
